

Advocacy for Peace and Development (APD) Organization Commitment



Narrative:

In South Sudan, we are currently providing education to 171, 631 women and girls on Sexual Gender Based Violence (SGBV), women (and girls) rights in Central Equatoria state enshrine in the constitution of the Republic of South Sudan with the hope to expand to additional two (2) states in order to reach 258, 241 female. Advocacy for Peace and Development (APD) organization will provide 91 women and girls in the first quarter of 2022 with rights-based family planning services including education. By 2026, in line with South Sudan national health Ministry strategy, we plan to expand these services to 258, 241 women and girls.

In addition to the above; South Sudan current policy does not allow for comprehensive sexuality education for adolescent girls and the organization would like to start covering Eastern Equatoria, Central Equatoria and Western Equatoria with coalition of Community Development Support Services and St. Monica Advocacy for Peace and Development, by 2026 we expect to have built internal government and community based support for changing this policy and to have established pilot comprehensive sexuality education in three (3) states of Equatoria region of South Sudan. The groundwork has been completed in South Sudan for creating a supportive policy environment to accelerate efforts to provide SRH services and CSE for young people through the newly developed National Sexual Reproductive Health Policy and Adolescent Sexual Reproductive Health strategy.

Outcomes:

1. Improved health care for 75% of women in Equatorial Region of South Sudan
2. 85% of women and girls take modern contraceptives as their rights for good health.
