Narrative:

Blind Youth Association is an organization established by the Blind and Partially Sighted Youth of Nepal. With the vision of 'BPS people of Nepal enjoying dignified life in an inclusive society' BYAN is currently working in the area of policy advocacy, education, employment disaster risk reduction and health and SRHR of persons with disabilities . While we move ahead to better realize the rights of persons with disabilities in Nepal, we will keep doing our current work while giving more stress on the SRHR by incorporating all categories of persons with disabilities as this area and associated issues are unexplored and need more attention. As the issue is being heard by the stakeholders and the PWDs are being concerned with the demand on SRHR, we put forward our written commitment to our target group. This plan outlines our future direction until 2030, has its focus in different persons with disabilities and their SRHR concerns regarding Rights claiming via Advocacy, Demand generation via Awareness and capacity building and Making inclusive supply via sensitization and Advocacy and policy change in the government systems. BYAN is hopeful that there will be good cooperation, support and contribution both from its existing and potential supporting partners while putting things into practice for the wider benefits of persons with disabilities in general and BPS in particular.

Outcomes:

- To promote the health rights and services of persons with disabilities with focus on SRHR.
- To generate the demand among the persons with disabilities and to advocate for making the supply side inclusive to reach the demand.
