COMMITMENT PROGRESS SUMMARY NARRATIVE

In spite of challenges of reduced procurement due to funding issues Mylan was able to provide its contraceptive products to additional 700,000 women in year 2019. Majority of these women were from emerging markets. In year 2019, we supplied our contraceptives to women in seven additional FP2020 focused countries.

In 2019, we also joined hands with USAID as a supplier of contraceptives products to USAID supported programs. As a part of our initiative we strengthened and increased our manufacturing capacities for WHO PQ oral contraceptives to meet the increased demand due to efforts of all FP2020 stake holders.

Our second objective was to register our products in more than 80% of FP2020 countries. We had achieved that objective in year 2018. However, to enhance the access to newer generation contraceptive we have initiated the registration of these contraceptive products in partnership with NGOs in Africa and Asia
