Narrative

SWAG Initiative provides direct family planning information and services to 200,000 adolescents and young people annually in Nigeria. Our services include family and life planning education, counseling, and information on a range of contraceptive methods and provision of family planning commodities. However, there are significant barriers that prevent many young people from accessing these services, including limited knowledge, stigma, and lack of availability.

By 2025, SWAG Initiative commits to expanding access to family planning information and services for 800,000 adolescents and young people in Nigeria, our commitment will focus on improving service provision, engaging with youth-led organizations, and strengthening partnerships with stakeholders to address the supply gaps of commodities and unique needs of young people.

Outcomes & Values

- Increased capacity of service providers: Through the capacity strengthening of 4320 service providers, by 2025, we expect to see a significant increase in the capacity of service providers by x%, which will result in quality service delivery to adolescents and young person's accessing FP information and services and ensuring referral linkages.
- Improved knowledge on FP information and services: Through family and life planning education and counseling, we aim to empower 800,000 young people with the knowledge and skills necessary to make informed decisions about their sexual and reproductive health.
