The main objective of the Unidos program is to co-design, implement and evaluate an effective program for the reduction of maternal morbidity and mortality and the strengthening of sexual and reproductive rights in children under 19 years of age and over 35 years of age in Bogotá, Cartagena. and in the municipalities of Pereira, Pueblo Rico, Marsella and Mistrató.

Objectives:

- Strengthen maternal and child health services in 34 health service-providing institutions with the goal of reducing extreme morbidity and maternal mortality by 2%.
- Strengthen sexual health and reproductive health services in 34 IPS, as well as CSE strategies in 36 schools to reduce early pregnancy by 2%.
