

#### **Terms of Reference**

# FP2030 Youth Ambassador - Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC) Region

#### Introduction:

FP2030 is a global partnership dedicated to improving access to sexual and reproductive health services, promoting gender equality, and empowering individuals. To strengthen youth leadership in the LAC region, we are seeking a committed **Youth Ambassador** passionate about the sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR) agenda to play a key role in activities leading up to and during the International Conference on Family Planning (ICFP) 2025.

# **Role Objective:**

The FP2030 Youth Ambassador will be a young leader from the LAC region (18–35 years old) who will actively contribute to the development and implementation of FP2030 activities in preparation for the ICFP and promote meaningful youth participation in these spaces.

### Responsibilities:

## Participation in virtual events leading up to the ICFP:

- Attend and actively participate in virtual events organized by FP2030, such as webinars, knowledge exchanges, commitment calls, etc.
- Share perspectives and experiences to enhance the content of the sessions.
- Promote youth participation in these events through their networks and contacts.

## Contribution to FP2030 team meetings:

- Participate in select FP2030 team meetings, providing a youth and regional perspective, particularly in discussions related to the FP2030 Internal Subcommittee for the ICFP.
- Collaborate on planning and developing activities aligned with FP2030 objectives.

#### Participation in the youth training program as part of the ICFP:

- Attend training sessions.
- Provide input and proposals based on the needs and realities of the LAC region.



Serve as a knowledge multiplier within their community or network.

# Participation in the ICFP:

- Represent FP2030 and the youth of the LAC region during the conference.
- Participate in panels, sessions, and other assigned activities.
- Document and share learnings and experiences to strengthen FP2030's impact.
- Report their learnings as an FPNN journalist during the event.

#### **Required Profile:**

- Young person aged 18–35.
- Reside in a country within the Latin America and the Caribbean region.
- Proven experience in sexual and reproductive health, gender equality, or human rights.
- Strong communication and leadership skills.
- Availability to participate in the activities mentioned.
- Commitment to FP2030's principles and objectives.

### **Duration of the Role:**

The role will last for one year, with the possibility of extension based on performance and FP2030 needs.

#### **Support and Benefits:**

- Support for participation in the FP2030 virtual advocacy training course.
- Opportunities for personal and professional development.
- Participation in high-level international events.
- Certificate of participation and recognition from FP2030.
- Coverage of costs related to participation in the ICFP (transportation, accommodation, and per diem).

#### **How to Apply:**

Interested individuals must submit an application that includes:

- An updated CV, including their age and country of residence.
- A motivation letter explaining their interest in the role and relevant experience.
